Course Description:

Students will attend all daytime sessions of the Conference (a two-day event). Selection of conference sessions are to include the Department of Education session, attendance at both keynote sessions, and a minimum of one additional breakout from two of the keynote speakers. Students will write reflections which summarize 3 main points and 3 classroom applications from each session. Reflections will be electronically submitted which clearly state the name of the session, time, and presenter. Students will read instructor selected publications written by two of the 2014 ITAG Keynote speakers.

Conference attendees will post their reflections, connections, and applications between the two required course readings by Rick Wormeli and Richard Cash, as well as materials presented during the 2014 ITAG conference at: <http://www.iowatag.org/wp-content/uploads/2012/07/FinalFall14.pdf>. The reflections will clearly connect new learning to practice. Students will have the opportunity to take part in an online post-conference asynchronous discussion. Students will be provided with access to an online site where they will respond to key questions that are designed to continue conversations for a two-week period following the conference.
