Both chambers gaveled in at Monday at 1 PM but his week was a short week due to the Easter holiday – legislators adjourned Thursday morning for the weekend.

During this short week work was finished on the **SF 2117 DE-APPROPRIATIONS BILL** (which was signed by the Governor yesterday) but legislators have yet to release joint targets or introduce any of the budget bills for **this** fiscal year. We expect targets rights after the Easter holiday.

We are at a similar place with revenue issues. The Senate approved **SF 2383 SENATE TAX BILL** and sent it to the House; the House has not moved it or the Governor Reynold's proposals (**HSB 671 GOVERNOR TAX BILL**) out of committee yet. In short, everything is at a standstill until budget targets are set and decisions are made on what taxes, if any, will be acted upon.

Per diems for legislators are scheduled to end on **April 17** so we anticipate revenue and budget activity this next week. At that point you will receive a regular legislative newsletter.
